# 2. General requirements for international students

Prior to their arrival, students need to arrange the following documents:

- Criminal Record Certificate
- European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)
- Travel Insurance Policy
- Accident Insurance Policy
- Liability Insurance Policy
- Transcript of records

In case students are to be involved in clinical training they should get the On campus Insurance Policy. It costs around 20 €. More information available at: https://www.oncampus.es/es/seguros/oncampus-uco

Additionally, students are expected to have a good command of Spanish. Spanish B2 level is necessary for incoming students.

#### 3. Requirements for Erasmus + students incoming

You can find the steps to follow in order to arrange the documents for your placement in this document as well as some useful information and advice.

- Application Procedure
  - 1. First of all, incoming students must have the **Nomination Document** sent by the Sending University.



2. It is also necessary to do the **online registration process** in our website. You can do this by following the steps specified in the same website: <u>http://www.uco.es/internacional/extranjeros/en/how-to-register</u>

Please note that your application can only be accepted if you have previously completed the online registration.

3. After this, students must complete the **Application Form** and **Learning Agreement** (See attachments below).

-These documents must be filled in by using a computer. They should be signed and scanned (high quality) before being sent to <u>rel-exterior@uco.es</u>

-Students can send the original documents by post or they can bring them to the Exchange Programmes Office once they are in Córdoba. Address the documents to:

When filling in the Learning Agreement please note that subjects must be written down as they appear in the teaching plan (without changing it), including the course code and its corresponding number of ECTS. You cannot take any course in a different semester. Please check our timetables in order to fill in the Learning Agreement since some subjects can overlap and attendance can be mandatory.

#### 3.1 CLINICAL TRAINEESHIP FOR MEDICAL STUDENTS

There are two types of clinical traineeships in the Degree of Medicine:

1. Clinical Practices: This clinical training is regarded as part of the normal teaching plan of each course. The length of this type of practices is about one week long (but no more than one week). They take place between the months of November and December (first semester) and between the months of May and June (second semester).



- 2. <u>Internships</u> (called "Rotatorios"): organised by the Faculty. Students who go on an internship will develop their activity under the supervision of a tutor belonging to a specific Clinical Unit. They take place in the hospital and last about 6 hours per day. Students are expected to attend their practices daily. The length of the practical training period varies depending on the Clinical Department in which the internship takes place. They take place between the months of September and May.
- Internal Medicine: 5 weeks (Exam)
- Family Medicine and Emergencies: 5 weeks (Exam)
- General Surgery: 5 weeks
- Specialisation (of your own choice): 5 weeks
- Gynaecology & Obstetrics: 3 weeks
- Paediatrics: 3 weeks (Exam)
- Psychiatry: 2 weeks

There is also the possibility to do an internship during the months of June, July and August for the Erasmus + Students for Placement.

Please note that students cannot do a clinical rotation if they are doing any othercourse from the teaching plan.

#### Documents

Students must hand in the following documents upon arrival:

-European Health Insurance Card (EHIC): It can be obtained at the Health Department of the home country.

-Accident and Travel Insurance Policy

-Valid passport or ID Card

-3 passport-sized photos (3x4 cm)

-Criminal Record Certificate. It will be necessary to apply for the same certificate upon arrival and before starting the clinical training.

- <u>Practicum IV.</u> General hospital care (4<sup>th</sup> year)
- <u>Practicum V.</u> General hospital care (4<sup>th</sup> year)
- <u>Practicum VI</u> Community and Family Nursing (4<sup>th</sup> year)
- <u>Practicum VII.</u> Specialized hospital care (maternal and pediatric care) (4<sup>th</sup> year)
- <u>Practicum VIII</u> Specialized hospital care (critical care) (4<sup>th</sup> year)

- Biochemistry (1<sup>st</sup> year).
- Nutritional Cares in Nursing (1<sup>st</sup> year).
- Transculturality, health and gender (2<sup>nd</sup> year).
- Basic cares in Nursing
- Pediatric nursing (2<sup>nd</sup> year).
- Community and Family Nursing (3<sup>rd</sup> year)
